Our teams are actively monitoring communications from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention ("CDC"), the World Health Organization ("WHO"), and federal agencies to ensure we are operating consistent with the latest guidance to contain the spread of SARS-CoV-2, the cause of COVID-19.

According to the CDC, cleaning is the necessary first step of any disinfection process. Cleaning removes organic matter, salts, and visible soils, all of which interfere with microbial inactivation. The physical action of scrubbing with detergents and surfactants and rinsing with water removes substantial numbers of microorganisms. If a surface is not cleaned first, the success of the disinfection process can be compromised.
